Of the nine construction of facilities projects reviewed, 100 percent complied with NEPA requirements; however, two did not fully comply with NASA guidance. The noncompliance exists because NASAs management controls for environmental compliance are inadequate in the following areas: planning, oversight, guidance, and training. NEPA noncompliance related to programs projects totaling about 3 billion could result in increased costs, schedule delays, missed opportunities for preferable alternatives and or public involvement, and adverse public perception. Due to the extent of NEPA noncompliance for mission-related programs projects, we consider this deficiency to be a potential material control weakness reportable to the Agency's Internal Control Council.
