Thus a Connecticut beneficiary could not be deprived in New York, by the New York statute forbidding alienation, of the power of pledging stock which he had under the law of Connecticut; (6) and in such matters the decree of the court establishing the trust in the original jurisdiction is conclusive in all jurisdictions; (c) but a trust is invalid if it is contrary to the law or policy of the jurisdiction where it is sought to enforce it. Thus a trust of land for a beneficiary in a jurisdiction where the beneficiary cannot hold land himself is invalid.¹ A trust can be enforced wherever the property is itself,² or wherever personal service can be got on the...
